Chili Cook-Off Rules

Each non-profit: that has 5 or more entries on behalf of their organization will receive an equal share of all proceeds raised at the door. Any person or business can enter the contest. **All entries must be on a table by 5:30pm.**

Each person must bring: their Chili already prepared with a way to keep it warm. Power will be provided.

Each entry: must bring enough chili to feed at least 10 people w/a serving spoon or ladle. Sample cups and spoons will be provided by organizers. Our goal is to have at least 100 to 200 entries. This way we can feed 1000 to 2000 people!

Each participating organization: may have (one) donation box set up at their booth for participants who would like to make an additional contribution to that specific non-profit.

Each participating organization: needs to commit to promoting the event to everyone within their organization and encouraging them to invite their friends through email, newsletters, and phone calls!

Each participating organization: may bring baked goods or small packaged food items to sell to those in attendance during the cook-off only. i.e. cornbread, cookies, cupcakes, baked goods, small bags of chips, etc...

All entry fees: will be combined together and put towards the prize money for the top 3 Chili's and the winners will be encouraged to donate their prize money to the Charity of their choice. (Per State law this is not required.)

Liquid refreshments: will be provided by organizers.
